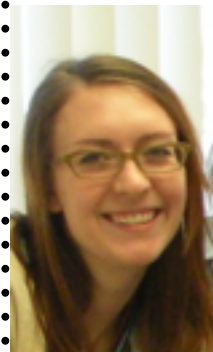




**Gen Med Welcomes Back Jessica Taggart!**

When your patients need Behavioral Health, please make sure you only send the referral directly to me, Jessica Droste. **Please don't send it to "Behavioral Health"**.

I know it makes sense to send it to BH, but when you do, every BH case manager, case manager student, therapist, therapy student, psychiatrist and manager gets it in their inbox.

I follow up on all referrals within 24 business hours of receiving the referral, and I document my contact with the patient in the chart (look for "social work progress notes" or "BH eligibility forms" – these are documents I complete).
